

Can My Child Come to School Today?

COVID 19 Questions

1. Has he/she traveled outside of Canada or been identified as a close contact?

YES

-Quarantine for 14 days
-Symptoms? Complete AHS Online Assessment/Call 811

NO

Go to Question 2

2. Is he/she experiencing CORE symptoms (new onset or worsening)?

(fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of sense of smell or taste)

YES

(to any symptoms)

-Isolate for 10 days from onset of symptoms
-Complete AHS Online Assessment/Call 811

NO

Go to Question 3

3. Is he/she experiencing OTHER symptoms (new onset or worsening)?

(chills, sore throat/painful swallowing, runny nose/congestion, feeling unwell/fatigued, nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea, unexplained loss of appetite, muscle/joint aches, headaches, conjunctivitis (pink eye))

YES

(to ONE symptom)

-Stay home for 24 hrs
-If symptom does not improve or worsen use AHS Online Assessment/Call 811
-If symptom improves your child may return to school (testing not required)

YES

(to TWO or MORE symptoms)

-Stay at home
-AHS Online Assessment/Call 811
If symptoms go away your child may return to school (testing not required) if symptom free for 24 hours.

NO to ALL

Your child can attend school
