#### Here are some ways you can help us:

- Please make sure your child has gone to the washroom before school.
- Let me (Mrs. H.) know if they have not eaten breakfast.
- Please send a water bottle, as our school is very dry.
- Check back packs every day for notes, art and wet things (lol) as we send home their wet clothes if they needed a change at school.
- Replace clothes sent home so that they have a change here.
- Dress your child in layers, as our room can be very warm, and they get hot while running and playing outside.
- We encourage you to send 2 or 3 snacks, as too many choices can be challenging for children at this age. We have some extra snacks at school if they are hungry.
- Special Helper Days start this month. We will draw names daily. We keep special days simple, and at their comfort level. They sit at the front during carpet time. They choose some of the toys we play with and get to be the leader if we leave the room, etc. Some children may prefer not to be the center of attention and that is ok, we will still make sure they feel special.
