PRINCIPALS MESSAGE

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.' ~John 3:16

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost. In addition to the liturgical celebration, many devotional exercises are connected with the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Of all devotions, devotion to the Sacred Heart was, and remains, one of the most widespread and popular in the Church. Understood in the light of the Scriptures, the term "Sacred Heart of Jesus" denotes the entire mystery of Christ, the totality of his being, and his person considered in its most intimate essential: Son of God, uncreated wisdom; infinite charity, principle of the salvation and sanctification of mankind. The "Sacred Heart" is Christ, the Word Incarnate, Savior, intrinsically containing, in the Spirit, an infinite divine-human love for the Father and for his brothers.

In the last few weeks of May, St. Paul grade 6 students and staff once again ventured into the wilderness of Southern Alberta for another successful outdoor education trip. The trip was filled with activities, fellowship, faith permeation, and of course, FUN! The two classes melded well together and built lasting relationships before they transition to junior high school next year. We've accomplished great things together this year. Let's make these last few weeks memorable, finish strong, and celebrate our St. Paul pride!

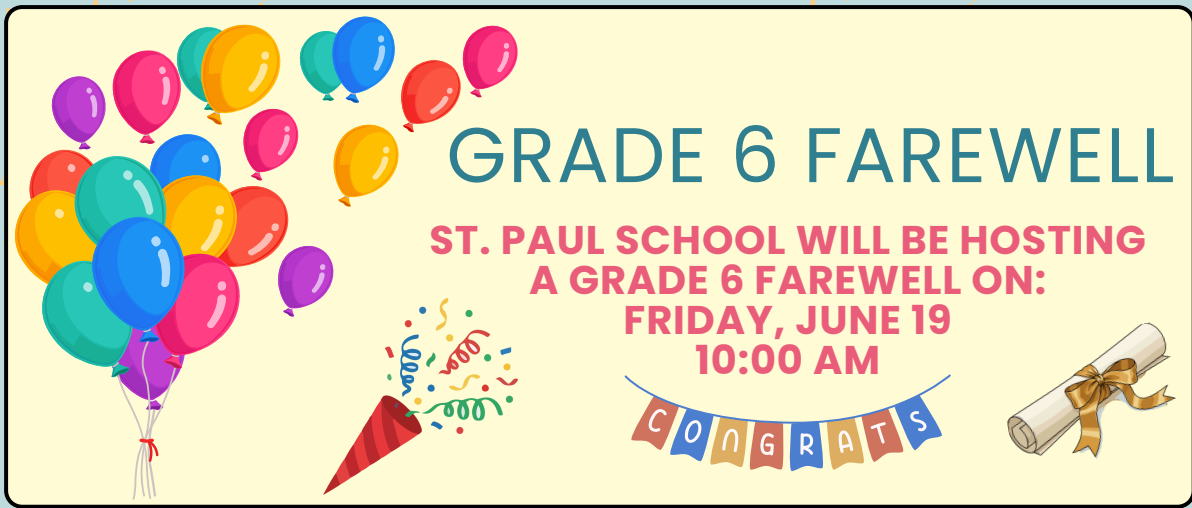
